ENTRY REQUIREMENTS/CONTEST RULES (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY TO AVOID DISQUALIFICATION)

1. “Entry” means one individual piece of work. Include 3 printed copies or 1 PDF of each entry with your entry form.
2. Multiple entries are accepted. **Each** entry must be accompanied by an official entry form *and* \$15. (You may copy this form or download forms from ssa-az.org. You may send 1 check or money order or PayPal to cover all entries)
3. Entries must be double-spaced on one side of white, 8½” x 11” (or A4 or similar) typing or copy paper, with one-inch margins, using 12-point Times New Roman or Courier font, in black ink only. Poetry stanzas may be single-spaced.
4. The title of the submission must be in the upper left-hand corner of every page.
5. Consecutive page numbers must be in the upper right-hand corner of every page.
6. The total word count (strictly observed) of each entry must be in the upper right-hand corner of page 1 **only**.
7. DO NOT put your name on any part of the manuscript. DO NOT include a cover sheet. Use title of entry for PDF.
8. DO NOT include artwork of any kind.
9. Staple the pages of each entry. DO NOT use paper clips.
10. Entries **must be** postmarked on or before **September 30, 2017**. Entries postmarked later than September 30, 2017 will be disqualified and returned to sender unopened.
11. Use regular mail. Certified or Special Delivery mail will be returned to the sender unopened.
12. All entries must be your original work and previously unpublished. NO simultaneous submissions.
13. Entries will not be returned. For confirmation of receipt of your entry, enclose a stamped, self-addressed post card.

Winners will be announced at the November 19, 2017 Awards Luncheon.

Winners will be notified by October 31, 2017. If you have not been notified by that date that you are a winner, you may market your entry elsewhere. All winning entries will be published in the SSA’s *The Story Teller* 2017. Some time after November 19, 2017, names of the winners and the titles of winning entries will be posted on the SSA website.
